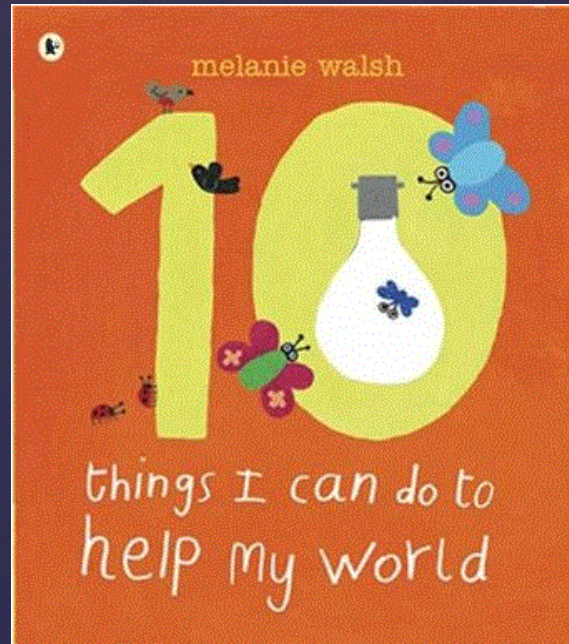


From Tiny Acorns Giant Oak Trees Grow



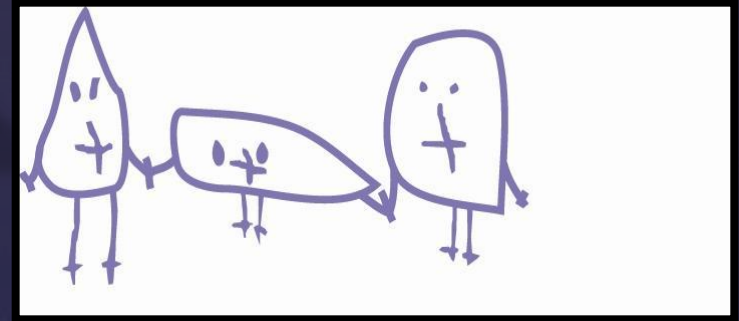

Sustainable development is development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the needs of future generations to meet their own needs.

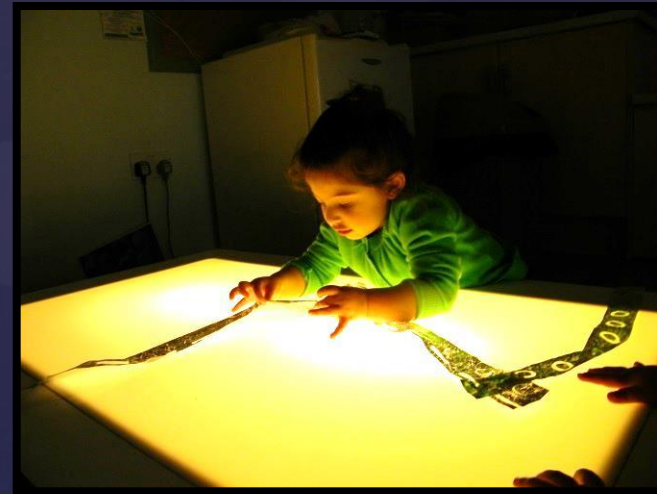
