# THIS HALF-TERM IN BLUE AND GREEN ROOM


## We will be planning to support children's interests including....

- **Shops and shopkeepers**— some of the children have enjoyed creating their own shops and engaging in role play based shopping themes. Children have been using the shop tills and independently counting out money to exchange for items. This has sparked conversations about family life and home routines. Why not go to the shops to buy ingredients for making something with your child.
- **Building and constructing**— both indoors and outdoors as the children have worked together to create some fantastic constructions. The children have demonstrated an ability to listen to their friends and take their feelings in to consideration. Children have also built their confidence in discussing their ideas amongst friends and staff.




## What we would like to teach our children about

- As the children have been enjoying our regular baking activities we have decided to focus on the story “**The Tiger Who Came to Tea**”. This will help us to explore not only food and the importance of healthy lifestyle, but also look at quantities and numerals along with the importance of sharing and helping friends.
- To enhance the children's interest in building we will be focusing on our new **woodworks bench**, looking at the different tools we have and discussing what we can use each tool for. We will emphasise the importance of safety by wearing our safety glasses and encouraging the children to explore the different materials, constructing with a purpose.



- We will be expanding the children's experience of shopping and different kinds of food by going on **trips to different shops** such as Tesco at the top of the road, Eastern European shops and Bradford market.
- We will continue to focus on the importance of recycling and following our Energy Code so the children will understand the importance of looking after our environment.
