<p>Monday 11th January</p>	<p>Bear Cave</p> <p>We are developing a lovely book area for the children in Blue room and this half term it has a bear theme. We can enjoy our core story "We're going on a bear hunt" and other books about bears. The children can act out the story using the props. We will encourage the children to use the rich familiar language, repetition and rhymes from the story.</p>	
<p>Tuesday 12th January</p>	<p> The Polar Bear and the Snow Cloud by Jane Cabrera</p> <p>Our children are enjoying stories about bears and learning about polar animals so this story about a Polar Bear, where he lives is and what the weather is like, really matches their interest. Reading stories like this is a great way to start conversations and spark curiosity about the world around us. Watch the read-along story at home.</p>	
<p>Wednesday 13th January</p>	<p>Arctic Animals</p> <p>In supporting our children's intersts in animals that live in the polar regions, we have set up areas in the classroom to encourage their curiosity. Adults will talk to children about these animals, where they live and what they eat. We like to use as many real images as possible to help children learn about the wider world.</p>
