
Thank you so much for all your lovely comments. It is wonderful to know how much you value the school. We are always learning from you and this is what you had to say about things we could improve:

Our Responses to Your Comments

We will always act on your comments or concerns. This is what we intend to do:

We have to keep our car park gates closed to keep children safe in school and prevent accidents. If you or your child has a disability please speak to Ginny, Sally or Hannah about parking in the school car park.



Parking is not permitted outside the school gates as this causes a hazard for emergency vehicles, like ambulances. They need access to the school at all times.

In September 2021 the Early Years Foundation Stage is changing. We will be changing the online assessment program that we use from Early Essence to Learning Journals. We will invite you into school in the Autumn term to find out more about Learning Journals and the assessment information we will share with you. We hope you find it a better system to work with.
